## **VOLUNTEER INFORMATION**

Woodlands is a non-profit organization dedicated to the care and release of orphaned and injured wild mammals and reptiles since 1986. Located in Alexandria Township, Hunterdon County, NJ, we admit and treat over one thousand animals each year. This amazing feat is only possible through our specialized volunteer program.

How you can help: Take an essential role in helping us provide the high quality care and expertise for which we are known! Each of the volunteer opportunities outlined below are vital for our organization to continue fulfilling our mission. *The work is not glamorous* but it is crucial to the care of the animals, as well as fulfilling and educational for you! While previous experience with wildlife is wonderful, it is not required and all opportunities receive thorough training. Respect for wildlife and the importance of volunteering is key. You must be 16 years or older. Volunteer shifts are from early morning until late evening. We ask all volunteers to commit to a fixed weekly schedule. All scheduling is described in detail during orientation and training. Vacations and other commitments are honored and covered by our Absence Policy (see manual excerpt). The needs of the refuge change from month to month as the animals' progress and the seasons change. Flexibility is important. While we have fairly strict requirements, we make the best attempts to work out scheduling conflicts with serious minded and committed volunteers.

## **VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES AND REQUIREMENTS**

\*Time requirements are the minimum

<u>HANDLERS:</u> Working hands-on with the animals, handling and feeding on a regular basis from their infancy to release. Every handler receives the same training regardless of previous experience and advances in skill each season. Other duties include, but are not limited to, cleaning cages, preparing food, dishes, laundry and other regular shift chores.

**Primary Handler:** Time requirement\* - 4 hour shift twice a week totaling 8 hours a week. This opportunity is for the serious volunteer who has time, flexibility and wishes to learn the most about wildlife and rehabilitation. Note: Pre-exposure rabies vaccination is the volunteer's responsibility and recommended for everyone.

**Secondary Handler:** Time requirement\* - 6 hour shift once a week. *This opportunity is limited to non-critical animals and non-rabies vector species*.

<u>ASSISTANTS:</u> Working closely with the animals without actually handling them. Other duties include, but are not limited to, cleaning, preparing food, dishes, laundry and other regular shift chores. This position helps a shift run smoothly and allows the handlers to concentrate on feeding and direct care.

**Primary Assistant:** Time requirement\* - 4 hour shift once a week.

**Secondary Assistant:** Time requirement\* - 2 hour shift. *This opportunity is limited to washing dishes, doing laundry and cleaning empty cages.* 

<u>BEHIND THE SCENES</u>: Opportunities may be available in marketing, grounds maintenance, cage repair, public education, and current events or fundraisers, depending on season and need. General office and organizing skills are also welcome. *If you have a skill you think may benefit us, but you are not interested in the above, please let us know!* 

After reading this material, we hope you take the next step by filling out the application and returning it. You will then attend the required 2 hour orientation which will include a more detailed discussion of refuge policies and expectations. A \$5.00 nonrefundable donation is required with your application to reserve your spot and offset costs (and can be paid online, by phone, or by check to the above address).

We truly hope you decide to join the volunteer program at Woodlands. We know your time spent here will be wonderfully educational and fulfilling. It is an opportunity to give back to the incredible realm of nature that we take from so readily.
